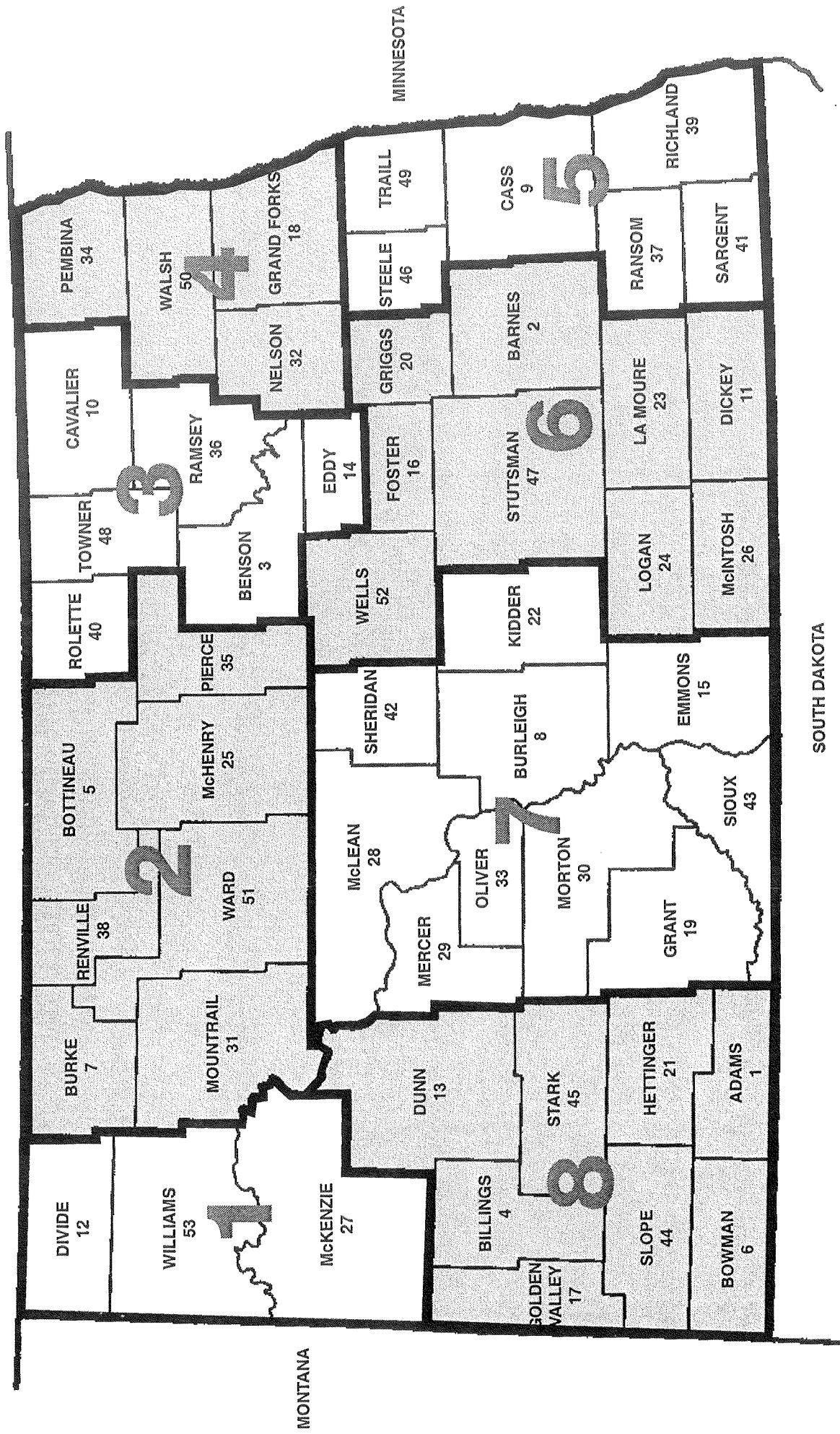

Purposes:

To inventory, collect, develop, organize, distribute and maintain an extensive database on the history of the peopling of North Dakota; and to develop grade-specific curriculum and teaching materials that can easily be integrated into daily classroom activities and linked to state standards.

Mission:

To help K–12 students in the state understand the social and economic value of North Dakota, a state created and enhanced by its ethnic diversity.

Focus:

To develop knowledge about the principles of democracy as expressed through the experiences of diverse groups that came to and moved through North Dakota; higher levels of human awareness as a result of greater appreciation for self, sensitivity to others and increased skill in functioning in diverse cultural groups and settings; and critical- and creative-thinking capacities needed for success in today's workplace and the increasingly complex interdependent, global economy.

Project Overview:

The program begins with core data supplied by the Institute for Regional Studies, state and county education organizations, regional historical societies and other repositories. As core data is received, it will be synthesized into usable curriculum and then mapped to the state standards and benchmarks for social sciences. The institute will then begin to identify gaps in the core data and locate appropriate experts to fill them. Educators familiar with the state's social studies instructional guidelines will carry out the curriculum development and mapping activities. After data has been organized into classroom components, teachers will be given instruction on how to use the curriculum effectively and imaginatively in their classrooms through a continuing education component.

By utilizing the talents of the Institute for Regional Studies, the program takes advantage of an institution that has experience and a well-documented expertise in the field of continuous updating of core data and its orderly retrieval. It has the internal structure and capacity to handle this task in addition to its existing workload and is capable and willing to expand its staffing to meet our goals. In addition to being a well-recognized repository for such data, it functions as its own publisher. We therefore consolidate several goals and endeavor to accomplish in 3 to 4 years what would take 10 to 15 years if it were done in a random manner.

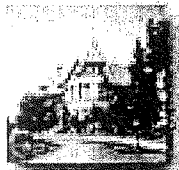

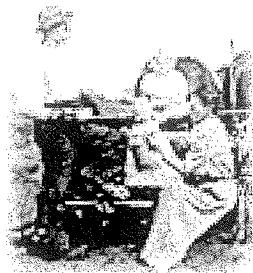

The Institute for Regional Studies has a number of North Dakota related collections and databases that are useful to those doing biographical, genealogical and family history research.

Databases Available on the Web

A number of locally developed searchable databases are now available on the Institute web site. They include:

Dakota Territory 1885 Census: This database includes over 127,000 names. All counties for the northern half of Dakota Territory, except Grand Forks, are included.

North Dakota Naturalization Records Index: This index was developed at the State Historical Society of North Dakota, where all original county naturalization records are preserved and have been microfilmed. This database contains over 212,000 names, giving the county where declaration and naturalization occurred and dates, and from where emigrated.

Fargo Forum Obituaries Index: This index includes all obituaries from 1985 to 1995. In addition, a small number of earlier obituaries found in the *Fargo Forum* are included. The database currently contains over 34,000 names. After 1995 obituaries can be found in the general *Forum* newspaper index at <http://www.lib.ndsu.nodak.edu/Forum>.

North Dakota Biography Index: This unique database to published North Dakota biographies indexes over 138,000 biographical sketches found in 540 publications. It includes all books published through 1980.

Cass County Marriage Licenses (Database coming late Fall 2001): All marriage licenses recorded at the Cass County Courthouse are now processed at the Institute. They come from the 1870s to 1944. Since marriage licenses were not required during the territorial period, some likely will not be found in the county files. A database will be available soon providing easy access to the almost 15,000 licenses on file.

- 1900 North Dakota (Soundex index on microfilm)
- 1910 North Dakota (No index)
- 1915 North Dakota (Burleigh and Cass counties only)
- 1920 North Dakota (Soundex index on microfilm)
- 1925 North Dakota (Cass, Cavalier, Dickey, and Divide counties only)

Naturalization Records (See Databases section for index to entire state of North Dakota)

The naturalization records for Barnes, Cass, Griggs, Richland, Steele, and Traill counties are available at the Institute on microfilm (Microfilm JK 322.N9N6 1991). All North Dakota county naturalization records are preserved at the State Historical Society of North Dakota in Bismarck.

Pioneer Biography File

(Microfilm F635.P56 1988)

The WPA Historical Data Project in the 1930s gathered biographical data on over 5,000 pioneer residents of North Dakota. The data, microfilmed by the State Historical Society of North Dakota where the originals are housed, is arranged by county and then alphabetical therein. Roll 34 contains an alphabetical index for the entire state. This index is available in printed format at the Institute. All names are also included in the North Dakota Biography Index database.

N.D. Federation of Women's Clubs Pioneer Mother Project Records

(Microfilm CT3260.N56 1989)

This project of collecting biographical material on women who have lived in what is now North Dakota prior to statehood in 1889 began in 1929 with biographies added until at least 1953. The data, microfilmed by the State Historical Society of North Dakota, is arranged by complete and incomplete biographies. Reel 1 contains an incomplete name index which is also available in printed format at the Institute. All names are also included in the North Dakota Biography Index database.

North Dakota Newspapers

Most Fargo newspapers are available on microfilm, including the *Argus*, *The Forum*, the *Daily Republican*, and the *Daily Courier News*. Library staff have indexed *The Forum* obituaries since 1985, which are available in print version (Inst. Rm. Ref. AI 21.F67 Obit.) and on the web. Other newspapers available on microfilm are the *Dickinson Press* (1883-1917). Other North Dakota newspapers are on microfilm and available through the State Historical Society. Consult *North Dakota Newspaper Inventory* (Inst. Rm. Ref. Z6945.N8 1991)

Andrew A. Rowberg Biographical File, 1914-1978

(Microfiche E 184.S2 R68 1989)

The 1,600 microfiche set was acquired from the Norwegian-American Historical Association. Beginning in 1914, Rowberg gleaned Norwegian-American newspapers and other publications which give information on Norwegian Americans, including obituaries (the majority of the items), and articles treating weddings, birth announcements, promotions, honors, tributes, and Norway visits.

North Dakota Tract Books

(Microfilm HD196.N9 T73 1995)

This microfilm set of the U.S. Land Office's tract books for North Dakota documents original land transactions (homesteads, tree claims, etc.), from the 1870s to about 1920. There is no name index, access is by the legal description (township, range, and section). A map and finding aid to the collection is available in the Institute. The actual papers for each transaction are located at the National Archives. Mail order photocopy requests must be submitted on NAFT form 83. The form can be obtained from: Textual Reference Branch-Land (NWDT1), National Archives and Records Administration, 7th and Pennsylvania Ave. NW, Washington, DC 20408.

Canadian Border Entry Records

(Microfilm JV220.R46 1990z)

These records are a new addition to the Institute's collections. In 1908 the Canadian Immigration Branch began to maintain records of those immigrants who entered Canada at various ports along the border. We have acquired the records for those Canadian ports which border North Dakota, including North Portal and Northgate, Sask.; and Bannerman, Snowflake, Killarney, Mobray, Morden, Gretna, and Emerson, Manitoba. The records vary in beginning date but cover through 1918. The forms asked for: name, age, occupation, country of birth, country of citizenship, mode of travel, traveling from where, destination in Canada, how much money they had, and a remarks column.

Cass County Divorce Records

The Institute has received the civil case files for Cass County District Court from 1874 to 1942. Included in these files are all divorce proceedings of Cass County. Access all files through the original index volumes, housed at the Institute.

Published Genealogies and Family Histories

The Institute collects published family histories and genealogies relating to North Dakota as well as all German Russian family histories. Currently there are over 500 such histories all of which are cataloged in the on-line catalog (MSUS/PALS). There is also an extensive collection of county and community histories for North Dakota, many with extensive family history sections.

Donating to the Institute for Regional Studies

The Institute for Regional Studies is glad to accept donations of publications, manuscripts, photographs, and other archival records which help to document the history of North Dakota and its people. If you have compiled a North Dakota family history or genealogy, or a finding aid to assist others in their search, please consider the Institute as a repository. EXHIBITS

Land in Her Own Name

Land is often known by the names of past owners. In North Dakota, "Emma's Land," Gina's Quarter," and "The Ingeborg Land" are reminders of the the many women who homesteaded across the state. This powerful exhibit tells the story of some of the women who endured the hardships and enjoyed the accomplishments of homesteading in their own name.

Pioneer Camera

The Fred Hultstrand History in Pictures Collection is one of the most known photograph collections in North Dakota. A combination of collected photographs and his own work, they reflect the rapid changes in the settlement of North Dakota from the 1870s to the 1920s. This exhibit highlights only a small number of the images found in the collection.

The Northern Great Plains, 1880-1920

The Northern Great Plains exhibit is part of the American Memory digital collection at the Library of Congress. It includes 900 photographs of rural and small town life at the turn of the century, from two of our photograph collections, The Fred Hultstrand History in Pictures Collection and The F.A. Pazandak Photograph Collection.

Unpacking on the Prairie, Jewish Women in the Upper Midwest

A century ago most Jewish immigrants to the United States settled in eastern cities, but some continued west to North Dakota, Minnesota and South Dakota. This exhibit, developed by the Jewish Historical Society of the Upper Midwest and the Minnesota Historical Society, tells the story of how Jewish women made a new home on the prairie for their families and themselves.

Kurke & Associates, 1915-1963: A Photographic Exhibit of William F. Kurke and his Fargo Architectural Firm

Kurke & Associates was the largest architecture firm in Fargo for several years. With it's roots in Fargo dating from 1913, it became one of the most influential architectural firms in Fargo, and perhaps in all of North Dakota. This photographic exhibit is a supplement to the online finding aid and information about the Kurke & Associates Collection.

Our Heritage: A Scrapbook History

Images from various Institute photograph collections are highlighted on this website which is part of Horvick Manufacturing of Fargo. They realize the importance of including such images of our past stating, "Just as we have roots to the land, we have roots to our cultural heritage."

Historic Architectural Survey of Bowman County, North Dakota

This award winning site, developed by Thomas Isern, NDSU professor of history presents the results of a county-wide survey covering small towns, farms and ranches in the extreme southwest county of Bowman. The site includes short essays and photographs that illustrate the history of towns such as Gascoyne, Haley and Rhame, the architecture of barns, sod houses, country churches and grain elevators and the ingenuity of plains folk who built cable cars to cross swollen rivers in the spring.

North Dakota Governors

This online version of a traveling exhibit produced by the State Historical Society of North Dakota features images and text documenting the ten governors of Dakota Territory (1861-1889) and the thirty governors of North Dakota.

Rough Rider Awards: North Dakota's Highest Honor

The Rough Rider Awards recognize present or former North Dakotans who have been influenced by this state in achieving national recognition in their fields of endeavor.

Toils induced by Weak Soil: A Photo Essay

On 1906 the Northern Pacific Railway undertook construction of a railroad grade east of Fargo, N.D. and Moorhead, Minn. Almost immediately, the grade began to sink into the earth under its own weight. Exhibit developed by Donald P. Schwert, Dept. of Geosciences, NDSU and Mark E. Peihl, Clay County Historical Society, Moorhead.

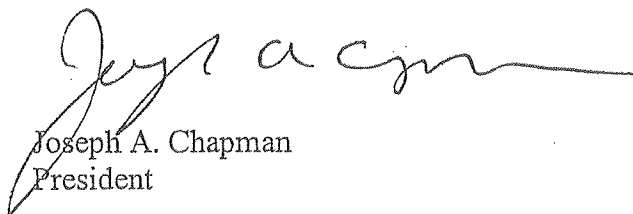

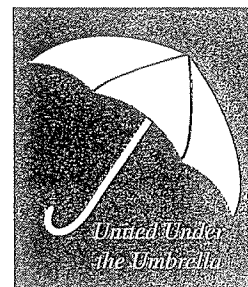
I look forward to developing Americans All North Dakota with our energetic group of partners and the People of America Foundation. Thank you for this opportunity to consolidate several mission-critical activities.

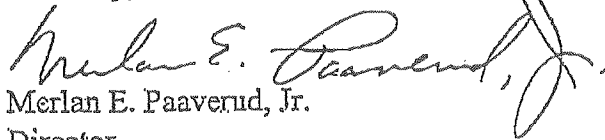

The \$32,000 grant will further the effort to inventory, develop and maintain the history of ethnic groups who are an important part of North Dakota's history.

The State Historical Society of North Dakota is working with N.D.S.U. as we discuss and consider options for collecting, recording, and utilizing this information. This information will be very important when we consider improvements in the curriculum that is currently used in our schools. This is indeed a very exciting opportunity. I hope that you will support this effort and award the grant.

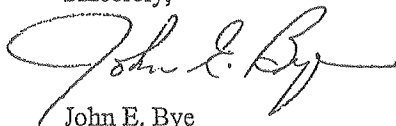

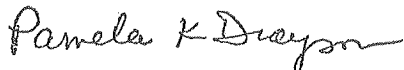

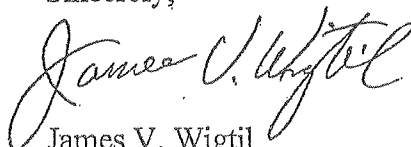

A Brief History of North Dakota State University

When North Dakota became a state in 1889, the state constitution called for the location of an agricultural college in Fargo. Congress enacted the Morrill Act in 1862, authorizing each state to establish a college of agriculture and mechanic arts. These land-grant colleges were to perform agricultural research and deliver technical and academic subjects to their students.

When such a college was authorized by the state legislature in 1890, it was named the North Dakota Agricultural College (NDAC). The first classes met in January 1891 and began with one building on the outskirts of Fargo. As the number of its student and faculty expanded, NDAC soon became known as the “people’s college” because it afforded common people access to a college education.

During the first 25 years, NDAC gained a reputation for its agricultural research and education as well as its outstanding programs in pharmacy, architecture, engineering, and veterinary medicine. This was followed by excellence in teacher education, the liberal arts, and the professions. However, because it was called an “agricultural college,” NDAC had difficulty attracting students from outside North Dakota and western Minnesota.

This recruitment issue was rectified in 1960 when a constitutional amendment changed the name of the institution to the North Dakota State University of Agriculture and Applied Science (NDSU). Today the university has an active enrollment of more than 10,500 students. The main campus houses 88 buildings on nearly 30 square blocks or 258 total acres. Taking all its facilities into account, NDSU comprises more than 22,000 acres of North Dakota land. This figure includes the main agricultural experiment station at Fargo and eight research centers.

The metropolitan area in which NDSU is located includes Moorhead, Minnesota, which contains two four-year colleges: Concordia College and Minnesota State University Moorhead. Since 1967 these three institutions collectively make up what is called Tri-College University. Its function is to encourage facility sharing and course exchange among the campuses. Student enrollment at Tri-College University totals more than 20,000.

Today NDSU promotes liberal and professional education along with agricultural research and education; is accessible, responsible, and accountable to the people of the state; and fosters North Dakotans’ economic prosperity and quality of life. Although agricultural research and Cooperative Extension Services continue to be major elements, NDSU is now a comprehensive university with numerous programs and services. It is a part of the North Dakota University System established in February 1990.

Project Director

Curt Eriksmoen, considered a leading authority on the history of North Dakota, was selected by North Dakota State University to serve as coordinator of the state's Americans All® project. He has had a long and distinguished career in business and education.

For the past two years, Mr. Eriksmoen has managed a \$1-million grant he received from the U.S. Department of Education to introduce character education in North Dakota schools. His efforts culminated in the legislature's unanimous passage of a concurrent resolution endorsing character education in the state. Several years prior to that experience, he was contracted by the North Dakota Legislative Council to work on the structure of state government. That work was instrumental in the restructuring of many state agencies. From 1974 to 1981 he was CEO of the corporation that first introduced electronic trivia games to bars and nightclubs across the United States. In the mid-1980s he managed a law office in Sioux City, Iowa.

A teacher of state history, government, economics, U. S. history, and geography at the college and high school levels, Mr. Eriksmoen also served for 12 years as social studies coordinator for the North Dakota Department of Education. During that time he received several awards for excellence and service. In his capacity as social studies coordinator, he was also named to about 20 different committees, including the North Dakota Interagency Council for Character Education and the council's Standards and Benchmarks Writing Team. He was selected to chair the state United Nations Day Committee for a record 12 consecutive years.

In addition to his business and education positions, Mr. Eriksmoen served as editor or co-editor of three North Dakota "bluebooks" and helped establish the *North Star Dakotan* newspaper. He was a major contributor of the elementary school textbook *America the Beautiful: North Dakota* and, for two years, hosted a popular daily radio call-in show. He was responsible, with others, for several innovations in North Dakota education, including the development of social studies resource kits and establishment of councils on various education topics.

Mr. Eriksmoen received his bachelor's degree in geography and his master's degree in history from the University of North Dakota. He holds certifications in teaching, personnel administration, personnel policy administration, instructional leadership and curriculum auditing. He also attended the Great Plains workshop "Great Workplaces '99: Attracting and Developing Talent."

Fiscal Agent

Nancy A. Olson is director, distance and continuing education, for North Dakota State University (NDSU); she took this position after serving for more than three years as assistant director. Previously she was a certification officer in NDSU's school of education.

A consultant and published author, she has participated in numerous meetings on education-related topics. She discussed "Character Education Anytime/Anyplace" at a Character Education Partnerships Conference in Denver, Colorado, and made two presentations and chaired a panel discussion at an International Symposium on Intelligent Multimedia and Distance Education in Baden Baden, Germany. She also took part in the New Faculty Workshop "Building a Dynamic Syllabus" in Fargo, North Dakota.

Ms. Olson was fiscal agent for a \$30,000 Continuing Education subcontract from the U.S. Department of Education to the Coalition for Character Education in North Dakota. She also served in this capacity for a Continuing Education subcontract from the U.S. Department of Education's Fund for the Improvement of Postsecondary Education Learning Anytime Anywhere Partnerships (FIPSE-LAAP) and the NAFTA Alliance for North American Mobility in Engineering. In addition, she participated in a Great Plains Interactive Distance Education Alliance/FIPSE Learning Anytime Anyplace Partnerships grant to several midwestern universities, including Kansas State, Montana State, Iowa State, Oklahoma State, and Texas Tech. She also participated in the \$700,000 Red River Watershed Education grant from the Otto Bremer Foundation to Tri-College University.

Numerous boards and committees benefit from her expertise. She serves on the Rural Social Science Education Advisory Board, the Great Plains Interactive Distance Education Alliance, the Federal Financial Aid Demonstration Project for the North Dakota University System, and Tri-College University's Educational Leadership Advisory Board. She was a member of the organizing committee for the 2000-2001 International Conference on Intelligent Multimedia and Distance Education and served on the NDSU Policy Coordination Committee from 1997 to 1998.

Recognized by her colleagues, Ms. Olson received the North Dakota Counseling Association's "Friend of Guidance and Counseling Award," in February 2002. She is active in the University Continuing Education Association and the North Dakota Council of Continuing Education Officers.

Ms. Olson holds a bachelor of science degree in English education from North Dakota State University, and she has taken courses in teacher education training, course development training, and web page publishing. She is working on her master's degree in learning and technology at Western Governor's University.

Editor

Chandice M. Johnson, Jr., was, for several years, director of North Dakota State University's Center for Writers, which provides editorial services, workshops, and other assistance to students, faculty, and staff. Mr. Johnson also was a senior lecturer with the university's English department. Previously, he was an adjunct instructor at Moorhead State University in Minnesota, taught continuing education courses at Mississippi Baptist Seminary and taught high school in Pend Orielle County, Washington. He was pastor of Temple Baptist Church in Fargo, North Dakota, for four years, and pastor of the First Baptist Church in Byhalia, Mississippi, for eight years.

Mr. Johnson wrote the section on rural literature for the *Encyclopedia of Rural America: The Land and People*, and he has written articles for *The Chronicle of Higher Education* and *Magill's Critical Survey of Mystery and Detective Fiction*. He edited *While in the Service: The Civil War Diary of Leonard Pierpont* and was co-editor of *Kaleidoscope 1: Emerging Perspectives on Community and Education*; *Kaleidoscope 2: Emerging Perspectives on History and Social Justice*; and *Writing, Reading, and Reasoning*. Mr. Johnson's writings have also appeared in *The Baptist Program*, *The Baptist Record*, the *Proceedings of the Linguistic Circle of Manitoba and North Dakota* and other publications.

In addition to his bachelor's degree in English from Oklahoma Baptist University, Mr. Johnson holds a master's degree, also in English, from North Dakota State University.

State Liaison/Assistant Director

William G. Woods, professor emeritus at North Dakota State University (NDSU), has had a remarkable 36-year career in education. He has taught all courses associated with undergraduate professional teacher preparation and reorganized and directed the teacher training program. Prior to his tenure at NDSU, he was dean of instruction at Wenatchee Valley College; field representative and curriculum writer at Central Washington Regional Supplementary Center in Moses Lake, Washington; and a consultant in systems design with Washington State University and the University of Idaho. He also taught at the community college level and in public elementary and secondary schools.

Developing a specialty in curriculum design, organization, and packaging, Dr. Woods has prepared, tested, and applied various curricular materials and teaching approaches. He helped organize, and worked in, various consortia of universities and public school districts; directed a center for community education serving two states; and solicited, won, and managed research and service grants.

Dr. Woods codirected the establishment of a computer network with e-mail and an Internet gateway for North Dakota K–12 schools, and he designed and monitored an evaluation study for a \$1-million federal grant to support character education. He also established a rural education enrichment project.

A respected speaker and presenter, Dr. Woods gave five workshop presentations per year on community education subjects, and he has presented or copresented at numerous other educational conferences. He served as a member and the president of the board of directors for the Learning Bank, a consortium of the public schools of Moorhead, Fargo, and West Fargo, North Dakota. He represented higher education on the board of directors of the Southeast North Dakota Educational Technology Consortium, which promotes the use of technology in K–12 instruction.

In addition to holding two bachelor's degrees, one in journalism from the University of Washington and one in English and journalism from Central Washington University, Dr. Woods received his master's degree in education also from Central Washington University. He received his doctorate in education from Washington State University.

Coordinating Agent for Research and Writing

Thomas Joseph Riley's academic and educational administrative career has spanned decades, and at present, he is dean of the College of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences at North Dakota State University (NDSU). Concurrently, he serves as director of the North Dakota Institute for Regional Studies—the publications arm of the university—with archives, research funding support and research programs in social sciences and historic preservation. Dr. Riley is also a professor of anthropology at NDSU. Previously, he chaired the University Senate Council and headed the department of anthropology at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign. As department head, he prepared and recommended the department's budget, including faculty salaries; chaired committees; oversaw hiring; and represented department needs before higher administration. He acted as liaison for interdisciplinary department programs and was responsible for overseeing tenure and promotion recommendations. Dr. Riley also served as associate dean of the Graduate College and coordinator of undergraduate programs for the university's anthropology department. He was assistant professor at New York University's Washington Square College, visiting lecturer for Smith College, and instructor and lecturer at the University of Hawaii, and he has held other teaching positions.

Dr. Riley's research activities have included archaeological field school at the University of Illinois' McKinney Oneota Site, metallographic analysis of selected Middle Woodland artifacts from Illinois at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology; preparation of archaeological reports for the lower Nuuanu Valley on Oahu Island, Hawaii; and archeological field visits and surveys at Fort Riley, Kansas, Vera Cruz, Mexico, and Cholla Do, Republic of Korea. He was principal investigator of various archaeological sites in the United States and assistant director of the Pololu Valley archaeological research program at Kohala, Hawaii.

A respected author, Dr. Riley has written articles for numerous journals, including the *Journal of Western History*, *Death Studies*, *Archaeology and Public Education*, *Perspectives in Biology and Medicine* and *Plains Anthropologist*, and he has written for archaeology and natural history newsletters and other periodicals. He has written book chapters on anthropology, has reviewed anthropology- and archaeology-related books for various publications, and wrote a syndicated newspaper column, "Other Times, Other Places," from 1975 to 1979, with 150 short articles on anthropological topics.

Dr. Riley holds a bachelor's degree in English literature from Boston College and a master's degree and doctoral degree in anthropology from the University of Hawaii.

Archivist

John E. Bye has been the supervising archivist for the Institute for Regional Studies at North Dakota State University (NDSU) for more than 25 years. He also has served as the university's archivist since 1987. In these dual roles, he heads the operation of the institute's manuscript and other collections and the NDSU Archives. He oversaw the cataloging of the archives' 1,000 manuscript collections, has written several guides to institute collections, and developed the institute's World Wide Web pages.

In addition to his archives and institute duties, Mr. Bye serves on the North Dakota State Historical Records Advisory Board, and he helped prepare and publish its two state assessment reports. He also teaches archival theory and archival photography in the NDSU History Department.

Prior to his current position, Mr. Bye served the institute as associate archivist. He was assistant serials librarian for the NDSU Library and acting head of its series department. He also was an indexer for the North Dakota Periodicals Project.

In addition to his bachelor's degree in history from North Dakota State University, Mr. Bye received his master's degree in library science and archival administration from the University of Wisconsin – Madison and has done graduate studies in history at NDSU.

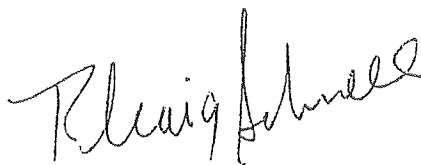

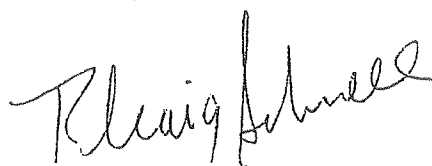

Thank you for registering for Americans All® North Dakota. As you know, your state has been selected to serve as a national pilot site for a historical investigation and curriculum development project with the People of America Foundation. The project's goals are to offer free, high-quality, locally approved, and diversity-based social studies materials as a supplement to existing social studies curriculum materials. Nevada and Vermont are also participating in the pilot. Including three states with different demographics and geographic locations increases the reliability of the test data.

Through this project, the Foundation will create a national Web site that will house state databases created by social studies experts within each state. These databases will make local and state history information available to students across the United States. In addition, all information in these databases will link directly to each state's social studies scope and sequence and to its assessment and testing requirements. Schools will also have free, direct access to curriculum and teaching materials used elsewhere in the nation. Further, by providing a greater choice of screened and approved curriculum and teaching materials, including text, audio and visual materials, the project will also provide more tools to those who teach children with special needs.

We have been contacting principals because you are the key decision-makers within schools. We have asked you to signal your support of the project to potential funders by registering your school at www.americansall.com. The response within North Dakota has been excellent. We are nearly ready to begin this initiative and want to update you on our efforts.

What does registration mean for your school? What are we asking of your teachers?

Project registration is an opportunity, not an obligation. It costs nothing for your school to participate in the Foundation's initiative. Registration ensures that your school will receive multiple copies of the print materials that complement the state's database and other free, state-approved curriculum and teaching materials. In addition, participating schools will receive a biweekly newsletter, access to special Web-based teaching sites, invitations to attend Foundation regional and national meetings, and opportunities for school personnel to participate in staff development programs. Who else in North Dakota besides schools has expressed support and/or interest?

We have received letters from the North Dakota Council of Educational Leaders, State Historical Society of North Dakota, North Dakota Humanities Council, North Dakota Institute for Regional Studies, and all of the Divisions at North Dakota State University that are involved in K-12 curriculum. Copies of those letters are enclosed.

What are the current registrations in Vermont, Nevada and North Dakota?

To date, schools representing nearly 78 percent of North Dakota's students, 63 percent of Nevada's students and 57 percent of Vermont's students are registered for the project. In addition, we recently received a request from Nassau County, Long Island, a large school district in New York, to participate in the pilot. We have already registered schools representing more than 20 percent of its student population following an initial mailing. Registration data by North Dakota school district is enclosed.

What does the Foundation need now to proceed?

We have met our thresholds for school registration and have received support from education organizations in all three states. Now we await the designation of management entities that will receive project funds in Vermont and Nevada. North Dakota, through North Dakota State University, has already satisfied this requirement.

When will the project begin?

Once all three pilot states have designated their management entities, the Foundation can officially solicit corporate sponsorship. We have been communicating with that sector for months, laying the groundwork for our official launch. We plan to announce this project to the nation within the next six weeks. As soon as funding is received, we will contact all registered schools to verify their enrollment, mailing address and project teacher names. We will then distribute materials to registered schools based on their enrollment and start posting data on newly created Web sites for North Dakota, Vermont and Nevada. We are very excited to begin this initiative.

As you know, North Dakota is one of three states selected to serve as a national pilot site for a historical investigation and curriculum development project with the People of America Foundation. The response from schools within the state has been excellent. We are ready to proceed and want to ensure that schools still interested in participating have the information they need to do so. This memo answers questions that principals have posed in connection with this project.

What is the project about in a nutshell?

A national Web site will house state databases created through the project. These databases will make local and state history information available to students across the United States. In addition, all information in these databases will link directly to each state's social studies scope and sequence and to its assessment and testing requirements. Schools will also have free, direct access to curriculum and teaching materials used elsewhere in the nation. Increased diversity within the student population requires more comprehensive and inclusive social studies resources. Moreover, an electronic database reinforces students' and teachers' desire to supplement textbook information with Web-based research.

Why are you contacting me, the school principal?

Principals are the key decision-maker within schools. To obtain funding, we need to demonstrate support for the project to potential sponsors. These sponsors are most interested in grassroots support by local schools. This is why we have encouraged principals to signal that support by registering their schools at www.americansall.com. Registering for the project demonstrates that you agree with the project's goals to offer free, high-quality, locally approved, and diversity-based social studies materials as a supplement to existing social studies curriculum materials.

What does registration mean for my school? What are you asking of my teachers?

Project registration is an opportunity, not an obligation, and it costs nothing for your school to participate in the Foundation's initiative. Registration ensures that your school will receive multiple copies of the print materials that complement the state's database and other free, state-approved curriculum and teaching materials. In addition, participating schools will receive a biweekly newsletter, access to special Web-based teaching sites, invitations to attend Foundation regional and national meetings, and opportunities for school personnel to participate in staff development programs. Further, teachers from registered schools will be able to electronically share their favorite lesson plans. As part of the registration process, we ask you to name at least two teachers who will help ensure sponsors that the Foundation materials will be put to maximum use. Their names will not be published nor made available to commercial list brokers.

Can this project help my school, which has children with special needs?

By providing a greater choice of screened and approved curriculum and teaching materials, including text, audio and visual materials, this project can provide more tools to those who teach these students.

Why do I need to take action now?

Our statewide training and materials budget will be based on the number of schools registered during the pilot phase. Although funding to serve additional schools may later become available, registering now guarantees that your students and staff will be first in line to receive project resources.

Where can I currently review national Americans All materials?

Three sets/boxes of materials have been distributed to each of the Teaching Learning Centers throughout North Dakota.

Other than schools, who else in North Dakota has expressed support?

We have received written support from the North Dakota Council of Educational Leaders, State Historical Society of North Dakota, North Dakota Humanities Council, North Dakota Institute for Regional Studies, and all of the Divisions at North Dakota State University that are involved in k-12 curriculum. Copies of those letters are enclosed.

What is the current registration in North Dakota?

To date, schools representing 77 percent of North Dakota's students are registered for the project. Registration data by regions and counties is enclosed.

What other states are participating in the pilot and what is their progress?

Nevada and Vermont are the other two pilot sites. To date, schools representing 63 percent of Nevada's students and schools representing 57 percent of Vermont's students are registered with the Foundation. In addition, we recently received a request from Nassau County, Long Island, a large school district in New York, to participate in the pilot. We have already registered schools representing more than 20 percent of its student population following an initial mailing.

When will the project begin?

Now that we have achieved a registration of more than 50 percent in each of the pilot states and have the internal support we need, we plan to announce this project to the nation within the next six weeks. As soon as funding is received, we will distribute materials to participating schools and begin placing data on the newly created Web site for North Dakota.
